WHAT TO PACK:

- **ONLY** pack in a soft sided canvas or mesh laundry type bag – details below
- Bible, paper, pen, pencil
- Pillow and bed linens (sleeping bag or sheets/blankets)
- Swimwear, beach towels, and bath towels
- Clothing, including outerwear such as sweatshirt, jacket, raincoat or poncho
- Extra clothes and shoes (to get muddy or wet)
- Personal care items and toiletries (any additional items needed beyond the basics)
- Bug spray and sunscreen
- Completed "Health Form" and "Custodian of Minor Release Form." These forms **MUST** be verified by the Camp Health Officer at check-in. The Camp Health Officer will also collect any medications during check-in and attend to special needs.
- Remaining balance may be paid at check – in but in advance would be appreciated
- For canteen money we recommend: \$5-\$10 for 3-4 day camps, and \$10-\$20 for week-long camps. Items offered in the canteen range from \$1-\$5. Additional t-shirts will be available for \$10 each.
- Refillable water bottle - We have "color changing" Kirkwood bottles for purchase in the Canteen-\$5
- **M25M provides - Basic Toiletries, Flashlights, Kirkwood T-shirt, Photo DVD**

WHAT NOT TO BRING OR SEND:

- Cell phones or electronics
- Expensive jewelry or items high in value
- Money – only send money for canteen campers should NOT keep money in cabins for security
- Fancy clothing
- Snacks or Food. Our canteen is fully stocked with chips, candy, drinks, and souvenirs. Canteen will be offered in afternoon and evening. Please do not mail food. No food is permitted inside cabins.

OTHER THINGS TO REMEMBER:

The following guidelines have been developed for our time together at Kirkwood.

- ALL luggage and bedding will be pro-actively heat treated upon arrival please pack toiletries & electronics separately. ****Please pack items in a canvas or mesh type laundry bag, or a soft sided bag****
- Our Camp Nurse / Health Officer is on duty 24-hours a day. Any illness or accident must be reported immediately. All medication will be kept in the health care room and dispensed as directed.
- No Smoking or Fireworks are permitted on the grounds for everyone's safety and health.
- Campers are to remain on the campgrounds unless special permission is granted by the Camp Director. ("Special Pick-Up Forms" will be available at registration)
- Lost and Found items will be kept for 30 days and must be claimed at Kirkwood. Items cannot be mailed or shipped. Kirkwood cannot be responsible for items lost while at camp.

For the Health and Safety of all who visit Camp Kirkwood, regulations made by the State and County Departments of Health, Sanitation, and Forestry are enforced.
